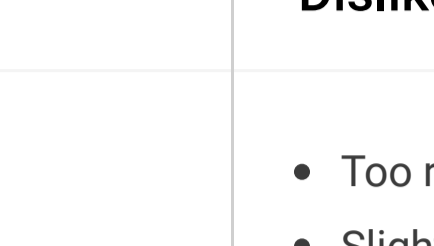
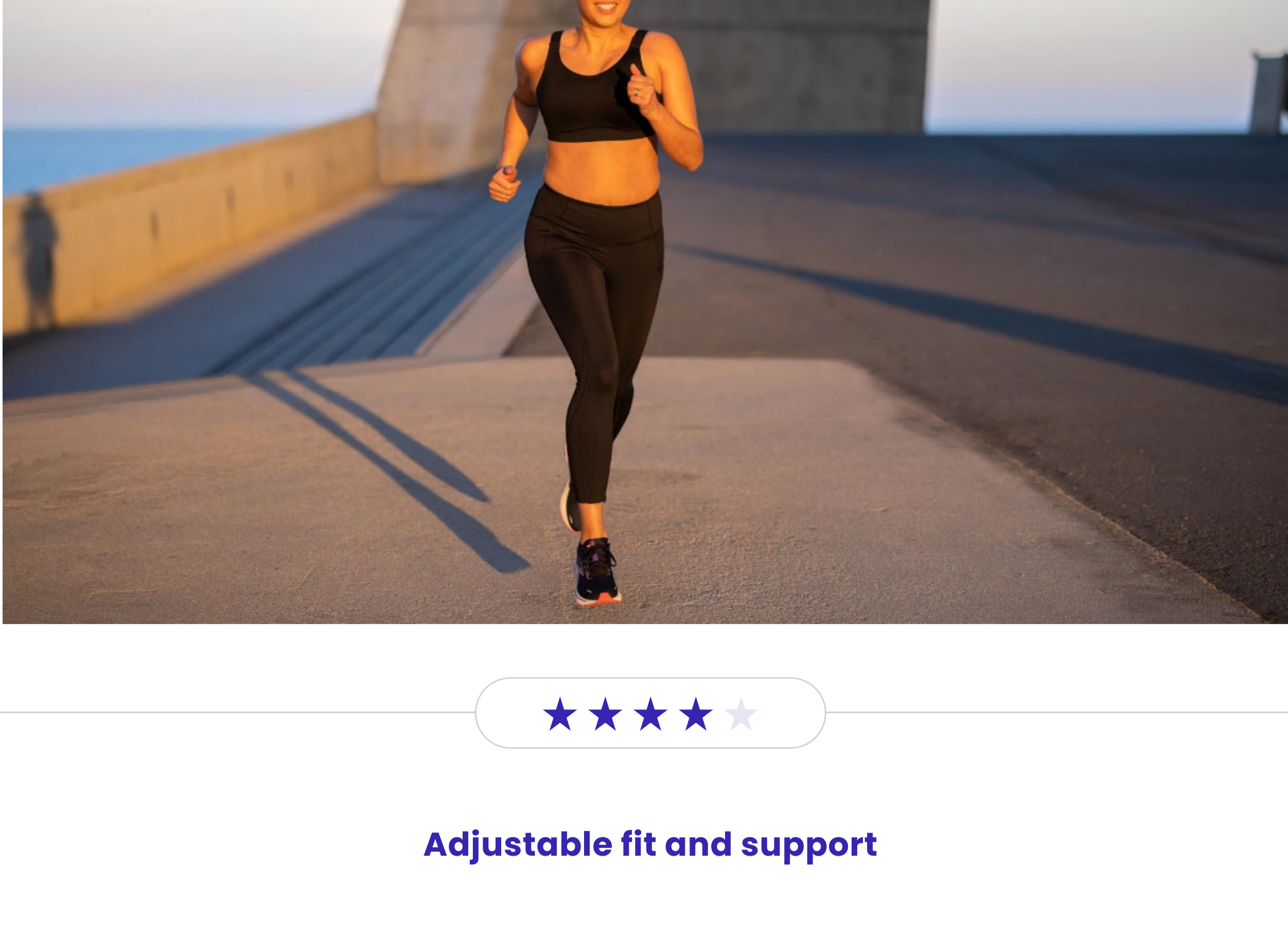

What's New

The Brooks Dare Scoopback 2.0 Bra offers versatile support with an improved customized fit. The bra features new hook-and-ladder adjustable straps and adjustable hook-and-eye closure for a stay-put, secure fit, and a longer integrated band for added support. Part of the Brooks Dare Bra collection, this bra has built-in molded unicups that encapsulate and lift each breast, reducing any bounce or motion for a comfortable feel. The scoopback design combined with mesh panels and strategically placed perforations provide airflow and ventilation, while the DriLayer HorsePower fabric delivers sweat-wicking properties to help keep you dry and comfortable on your run.

The Bottom Line

Our testers enjoyed the high-quality, seamless design of the Scoopback 2.0 bra and the smooth band that provided comfortable support. The built-in cups offered modest coverage and made for easy laundering. We also liked the adjustable features of the straps and the smoothness of the under band in providing a customized fit for versatile performance and wear. We recommend the Scoopback 2.0 Bra for ladies looking for a structured sports bra with adjustable features for a personalized fit.

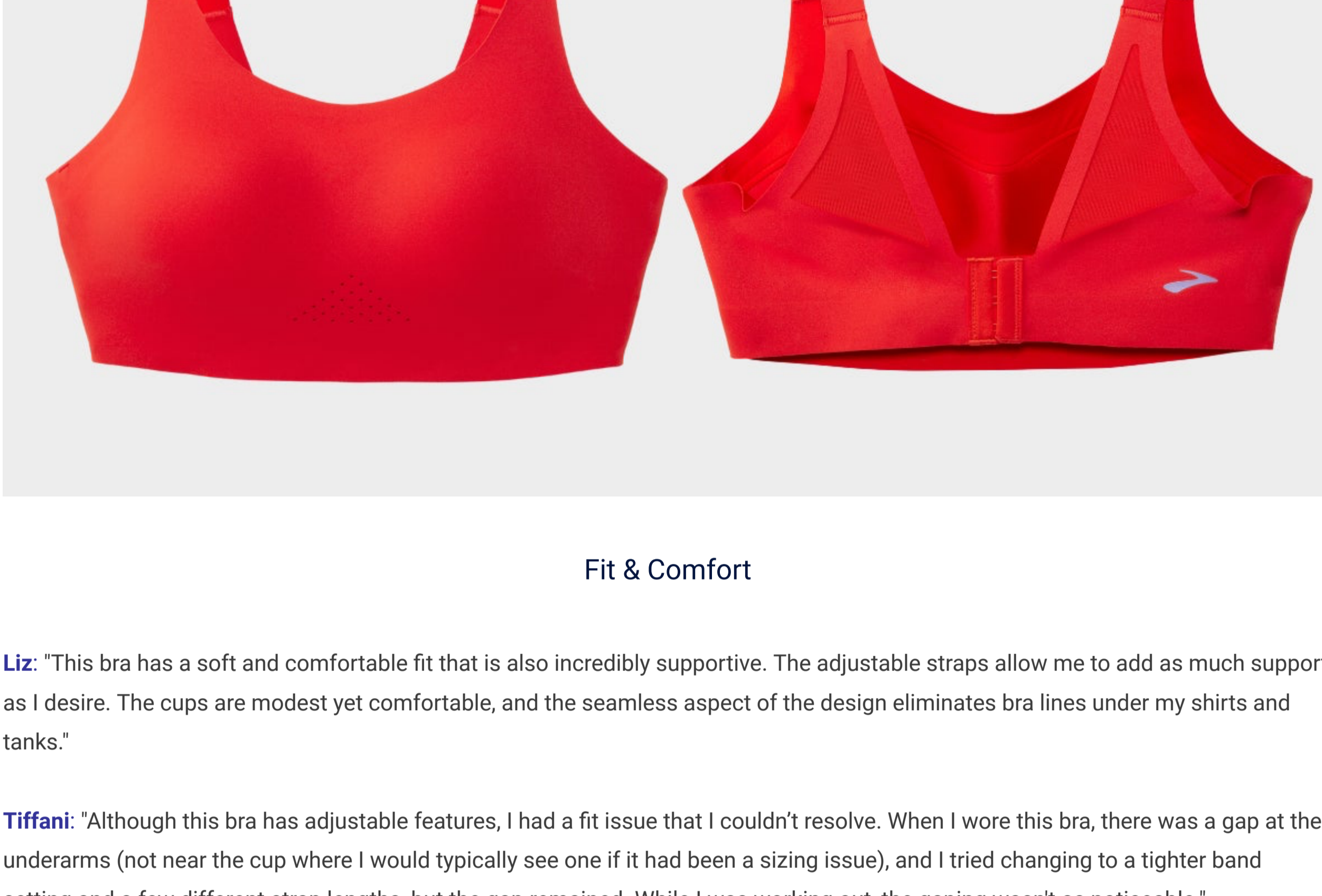

Our In-Depth Look

Features & Style

Liz: "This bra's features are simple yet very functional. It has adjustable straps and rear closure that offer a customized fit. I have never owned a sports bra that was this similar in design to a regular, everyday bra, but I ended up really enjoying this bra."

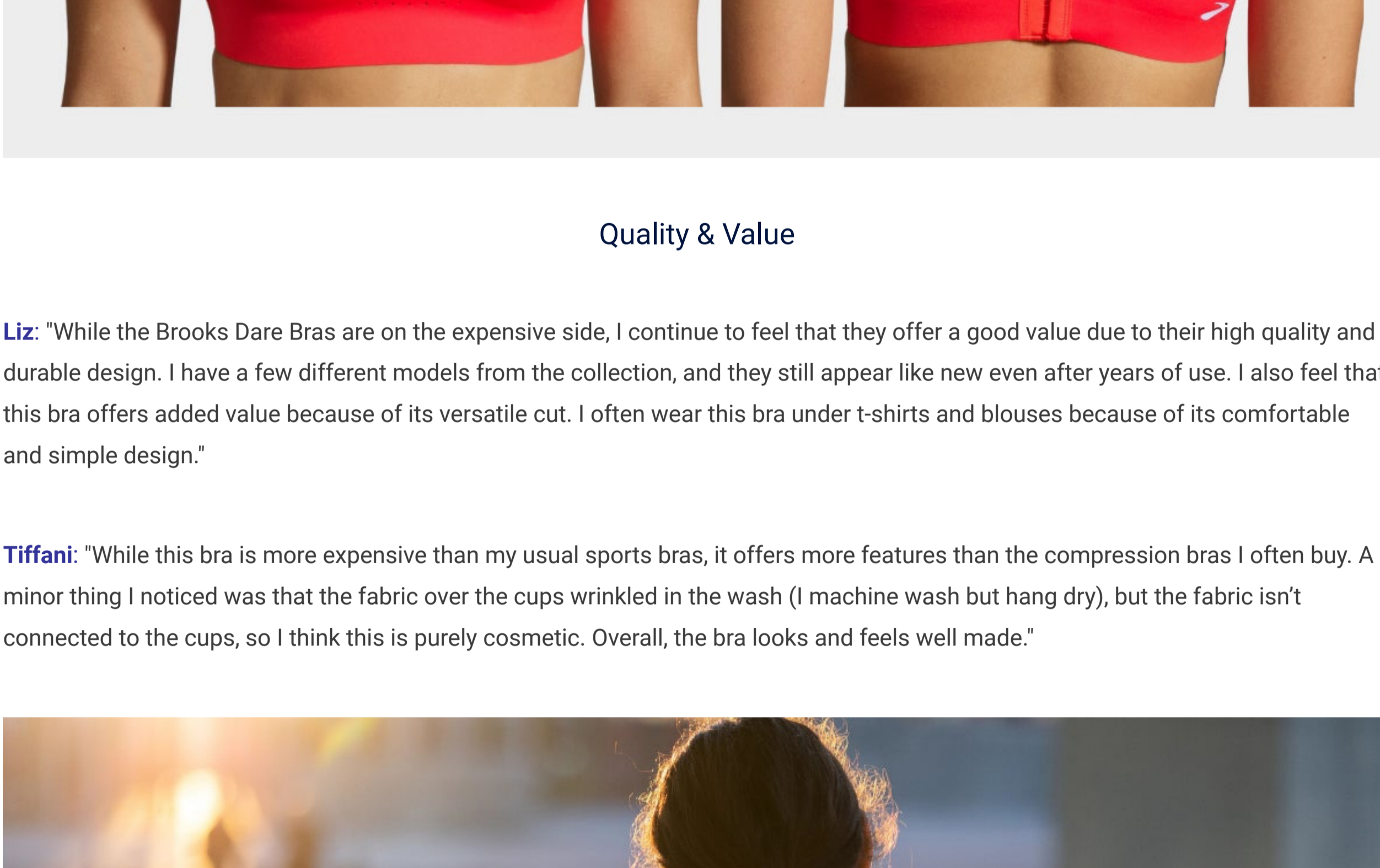
Tiffani: "This bra has all the bells and whistles! The bra features mesh inserts with bonded seams and an adjustable chest band and straps. I don't typically wear sports bras with a hook/eye closure because I prefer the ease of the pullover style, but the design of this chest band has a smooth finish, which feels comfortable and did not dig into the skin as much. My only issue was with the customized straps. Although the hook-and-ladder style adjuster may have helped prevent slippage and limited re-adjusting, I wanted easier adjustability. Usually, I wear bras without cups or with removable padding that I end up not putting back in after laundering because of the difficulty in positioning them right. But I like that this bra has built-in molded cups, so there is no fuss or struggle with them sitting smoothly."



Fit & Comfort

Liz: "This bra has a soft and comfortable fit that is also incredibly supportive. The adjustable straps allow me to add as much support as I desire. The cups are modest yet comfortable, and the seamless aspect of the design eliminates bra lines under my shirts and tanks."

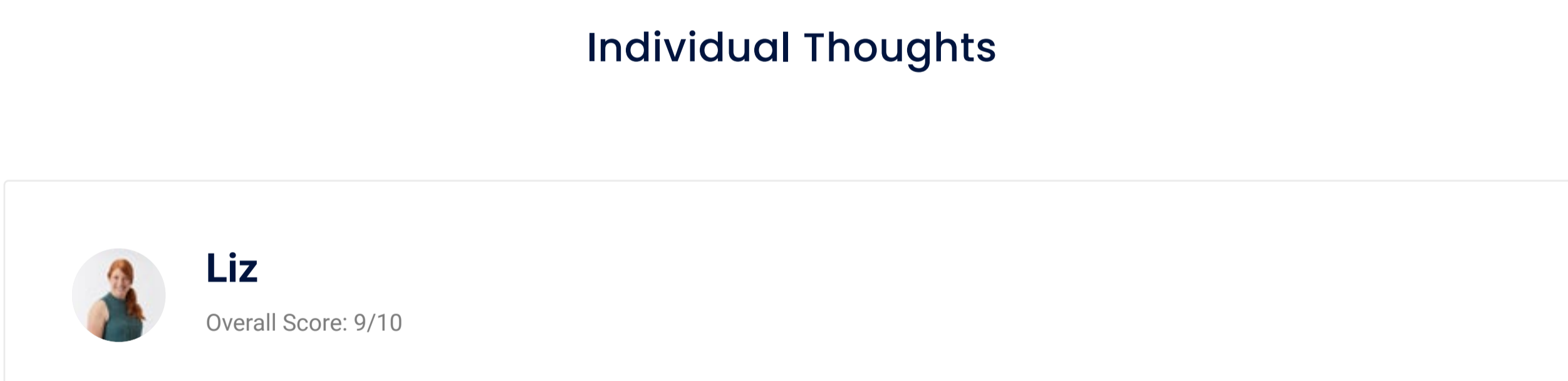
Tiffani: "Although this bra has adjustable features, I had a fit issue that I couldn't resolve. When I wore this bra, there was a gap at the underarms (not near the cup where I would typically see one if it had been a sizing issue), and I tried changing to a tighter band setting and a few different strap lengths, but the gap remained. While I was working out, the gaping wasn't as noticeable."



Quality & Value

Liz: "While the Brooks Dare Bras are on the expensive side, I continue to feel that they offer a good value due to their high quality and durable design. I have a few different models from the collection, and they still appear like new even after years of use. I also feel that this bra offers added value because of its versatile cut. I often wear this bra under t-shirts and blouses because of its comfortable and simple design."

Tiffani: "While this bra is more expensive than my usual sports bras, it offers more features than the compression bras I often buy. A minor thing I noticed was that the fabric over the cups wrinkled in the wash (I machine wash but hang dry), but the fabric isn't connected to the cups, so I think this is purely cosmetic. Overall, the bra looks and feels well made."



Individual Thoughts

Overall Score: 9/10

The Dare Scoopback 2.0 Bra is a great option for those who want a comfortable fit, and adjustable support and easy on/off wear. I had never tried a sports bra with the traditional hook closure system, and I wasn't sure what to expect. The Dare Scoopback bra quickly became one of my favorite bras for running and casual wear. I love the adjustability this bra offers with the hook closure in the back and the adjustable straps, which allow me to customize the amount of impact support I want for that day or workout. The lightweight, breathable fabric offers a comfortable, seamless fit that eliminates any pressure points or bra lines, and the moisture-wicking material helps prevent chafing on long runs. I have worn this bra for everything from races to everyday wear under my casual clothes, and I am not disappointed.

Tiffani

Overall Score: 8/10

I generally wear racerback bras that are pullovers with compression-led support, but it was nice trying on this bra and venturing out from what I usually gravitate to. A favorite of mine by Brooks a while back was the Just Right Racer, but this Dare Scoopback bra is more structured with built-in padding that lifts. The support level of this bra ranges from medium to high, and it has many features that other sports bras don't offer in terms of customization. Although I liked the ability to adjust the length of the bra straps, the design seemed too restrictive for me, and there wasn't a lot of stretch in the material for movement, so it may not conform to all body types. Overall, I found the Scoopback 2.0 bra offered better all-day comfort than most other bras in the market.
